Firstly, if they are attending ESC 2015 they will be able to watch it live on the AstraZeneca booth (E100 & 150) with the added benefit of being able to interact direct with the session moderator, Professor Carlo Di Mario (Imperial College London, UK) who will have an open line of communication with Dr Davies in the cath lab.
