Our Mission

The Catalyst Accelerator empowers nontraditional technology companies to accelerate their involvement in the national defense ecosystem by providing connections, mentorship, and business development in a collaborative setting for a lasting national impact.

Description

The Catalyst Accelerator is designed to increase the Department of Defense's (DoD) awareness of commercial technology that supports national defense mission sets. It is a semi-residential, three-month program for small businesses that provide business development training, connections with users and DoD liaisons, and fosters mentorship with industry and DoD subject matter experts. The Catalyst Accelerator does not assume an equity stake in the Accelerator cohort companies, and instead relies upon sponsorship funds to support the companies' travel costs and to enhance the Accelerator program.

The Catalyst Accelerator in Ogden is powered by the United States Air Force and its Digital Transformation Office (DTO). It is based on the proven model of the Catalyst Accelerator in Colorado Springs and had its debut in the Spring of 2022. The Catalyst Accelerator program has launched eleven successful Accelerators to date with 86 participating companies. By the end of 2021, the Catalyst Accelerator had launched eight cohorts with 62 participating companies, 284 contracts won, over \$290M in contract follow-on funding, 933 jobs created, and over \$650k in sponsorship funds. The economic impact associated with the three Accelerator cohorts hosted in 2022—including the inaugural Catalyst Accelerator in Ogden—will be available in 2023..

The theme for the Spring 2023 Catalyst Accelerator Ogden is digital models.

2023 Accelerator Timeline

The Accelerator is currently scheduled to begin in February 2023 and run through May 2023.



Ogden's Accelerator program had its debut in the Spring of 2022 with eight cohort companies. Throughout the program, companies were able to meet and network with industry leaders, advisors, and specialists. While the Accelerator's impact will become available in 2023, some of the resultant revenue-producing accomplishments and ecosystem impacts are highlighted below.

THE HOW:

SBIR and STTR Programs

Industry-driven and government-funded Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) and Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) aim to fill the critical gap of discovery, development, and integration of affordable warfighting technologies for our air, space, and cyberspace force. The SBIR and STTR programs fund a diverse portfolio of startups and small businesses across technology areas and markets to stimulate technological innovation, meet federal research and development (R&D) needs, and increase commercialization. The 2023 Catalyst Accelerator Ogden's schedule aligns with the application windows for SBIRs and STTRs to streamline the DoD's ability to secure a cohort company's technology solution to a stated DoD need.

IMPACT:

Utah Aerospace and Defense Cluster

Catalyst Campus is partnered with the City of Ogden to lower the barrier of entry for technology adoption into the DoD and drive modern capabilities to the warfighter. Ogden is focused on growing a robust and regenerative ecosystem that produces the innovation, workforce training, talent growth, and economic opportunities that the Utah aerospace and defense industry needs to thrive. This collaborative ecosystem enables industry, small businesses, entrepreneurs, startups, and venture capitalists to intersect with the aerospace and defense industry to create a community cluster, spark innovation and stimulate business growth.

Within the Utah Aerospace and Defense Cluster, Hill Air Force Base (AFB) has an impressive local economic impact as the largest singlesite employer in Utah with a total annual economic impact of over \$7.1 billion. Hill AFB creates over \$3.8 billion in indirect jobs and created over 56,600 job opportunities. There are nearly 22,000 employees working within Hill AFB. Over 5,000 of those employees are military, over 14,000 are civilians, and the remainder are contractors. Hill AFB has an annual federal payroll of nearly \$1.6 billion and annual expenditures of nearly \$1.7 billion.



WHO:

Air Force Material Command's Digital Transformation Office

The DTO is responsible for digital transformation initiatives across the Air and Space Force. It is focused on leveraging modern digital technologies and facilitates collaboration across Department innovators, AFWERX, and DAF Software Factories. The DTO is the Government sponsor for the Catalyst Accelerator Ogden. As the Government sponsor, the DTO shapes the problem statement addressed by each cohort and provides use cases that help the companies identify how their technologies fit within the DoD.

Air Force Research Laboratory (AFRL)

The U.S. Air Force awarded Northrop Grumman a \$13.3 billion contract to modernize a crumbling Minuteman III infrastructure by developing a next-generation Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM). The replacement of the 400 aging missiles will cost 83 billion dollars and take until the mid-2030s. Hill Air Force Base is slated to host a new Mission Integration Facility that will serve as a headquarters for these new modern initiatives. This initiative is the US Air Force's first major program to earn the e-Programs designator, meaning it leverages digital engineering, agile software development, and open systems architecture. The Catalyst Accelerator Ogden focuses on U.S. Air Forceenterprise digital solutions that can support modern, fully integrated digital systems, commercial tech transfer, innovation, and workforce development programs.

Software Engineering Group

The 309th Software Engineering Group, (SWEG), is comprised of 2,100 engineers, technicians, computer scientists, cyber security specialists, information technologists, configuration managers, and expert support personnel. SWEG's primary customers are the System Program Offices for fighter aircraft and for missile and space systems. This grants it a diverse workload ranging from developing Software Integration Laboratory environments, command and control and space systems for Sentinel, and aircraft programming. The Catalyst Accelerator Ogden has a digital focus that supports use cases within SWEG and supports rapid modernizations of warfighter capabilities.



Overview
