What's in it for you:

Actionables are based on the *Know-Do-Reflect* loop. Here the three components in more detail:



• STEP 1 – KNOW

Each Actionable starts with a course that offers a 15-minute overview of a business-relevant topic based on getAbstract summaries. The courses are highly engaging thanks to their well-balanced mix of video-, audio-, text- and reflection components. For additional background reading, you can access course-relevant getAbstract summaries via hyperlinks embedded in each course.

• STEP 2 – DO

A concrete call to action prompts you to apply the knowledge right away.

• STEP 3 – REFLECT

The Peer Insights tool asks you to reflect on your experience of putting the newly acquired knowledge into action. Once you've submitted your feedback, you will have access to the aggregated, anonymized insights from peers as soon as they become available.
