In order to create the Veteran Health Record, approximately 130 instances of VistA, as well as many other VA assets such as the Master Veterans Index (MVI) and the Identity and Access Manager (IAM), will be integrated under the VDIF EP.

EHRM depends on the successful sustainment and integration with the VDIF Enterprise Platform. Given the VDIF EP is based on InterSystems HealthShare, finding a strategic implementation partner certified in InterSystems HealthShare was key. After a competition, the VA selected Ready Computing.
