


## Opinion Research for Decision Making in Politics and Public Affairs

The recently conducted survey of voters in the United States indicates widespread opposition to the LIV golf league, and a large majority would also be less likely to support a candidate for public office who supports the Saudi Arabian funded LIV Golf league. Specific results include the following:

- 1. Initially, 47% oppose the Saudi Arabian funded LIV golf league, and only 12% support it.
- 2. Respondents were read five statements about the LIV Golf Tour, to which large majorities responded negatively to each one. The preamble to these questions, which were randomized, was as follows:

"For each statement, please tell me whether this information would make you more likely to support or oppose the LIV Golf Tour or does it make no difference to you."



- 3. After these five informative statements, respondents were asked a second time if they supported or opposed the LIV golf league. Five out of seven (72%) of national respondents oppose the LIV golf league after learning more about it.
- 4. From the initial question to the informed question, 28% of respondents switched from being in support of or having no opinion of the LIV golf league to opposing it.
- 5. After these five informative statements, 57% of voters would be less likely to vote for a candidate for public office who supports the Saudi Arabian funded LIV golf league. Only five percent would be more likely to vote for such a candidate.
- 6. 64% of voters oppose former President Trump hosting Saudi Arabia backed LIV Golf league at his golf clubs in Bedminster, New Jersey and Doral, Florida outside Miami.

Interviewing was conducted October 22-24, 2022, among N=845 voters across the United States. The margin of error to the results of 845 interviews is  $\pm$  3.4 at the .95 confidence interval. All results rounded to the nearest whole percentage.
