Strong historical clothing element at October 12th-13th Show


VINTAGE PRODUCTIONS

A LL-AMERICAN SHOW DEAL-ERS Margo Essman and Jim Maley will be setting up at the premiere L.A. Vintage Rendezvous slated for October 12th and 13th at Fairplex in Pomona.

All-American Show co-owner Jim Maley is especially enthusiastic about the new show's vintage workwear slant.

He is going to be bringing a vintage advertising that shows of vintage uniforms and



fashion, including an early 1920s advertising fan for Ellwood J. Boehm car batteries, which features a well-dressed lady standing on the side panel of her car and using her binoculars to look at some biplanes. He hopes it flies off for \$65.

Maley will also be bringing a high schoolsized leather football helmet.

### Margo Essman recently acquired a 2,500 piece toy train catalog collection including catalogs and flyers

CHE DEBUTED A number of the 31950s and '60s mint pieces, some in original boxes and wrappers, at the August All-American Show, and she will

be bringing some of her best catalogs, booklets and brochures to the Rendez-

She purchased the collection from Jack White, broadcaster and magician from the San Diego area. His mother had a toy shop and train store from the 1940s through the 1970s, and when she retired, her son took over and put the toy train ephemera into storage.

"We found out about this massive collection and we were invited to come and we

bought over 2,500 amazing toy catalogs and they look like they came out the of print shop," she said. Included in her inventory is a 40-page catalog featuring Lionel Trains

with Magne Traction from 1956, a 48-page Gilbert American Flyer Catalog from 1957, a 1958-59 American Flyer fold-open poster catalog that features 16 panels, and a 72-page Lionel train catalog from 1961.



She would be willing to sell the whole lot for \$7,500. "That's a steal because these usually sell for \$40 to \$48 a piece."
